The City of Gardiner will hold a public meeting on the Kennebec Valley Council of Governments (KVCOG), U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and Maine Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) Brownfields-funded Cleanup Project at the T.W. Dick properties located on Summer Street in Gardiner, Maine (the "Site"). The public meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 26, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at the Gardiner City Hall (6 Church Street, Gardiner, Maine).

The City has selected three cleanup contractors: Envirovantage of Epping, New Hampshire; J.E. Butler of Brewer, Maine; and Steven McGee Construction of West Gardiner, Maine. These contractors, along with the City's consultant, Ransom Consulting, Inc., will be available to answer questions about the proposed cleanup actions, schedule, and procedures for work to be conducted at the Site.

The information repository on this project, including the Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives, prior environmental assessments, bid results, and other environmental information is located at the Gardiner City Hall and is available for viewing during normal business hours.
